Senior Athletics

I would like to congratulate all the students who get involved on a regular basis with all the experiences and activities the school offers. We saw this last Thursday at the Year 5-8 Senior Athletics at Mt Smart Stadium. Students got to participate in the 60m, 100m, 200m track races as well as the High Jump, Long Jump, Ball Throw, Discus and Shot Put. Mathex

Another successful activity we saw last week was the annual Year 5&6 Mathex competition held at St Kentigern School. This is an event not to be missed and always enjoyed by both participants and spectators. 16 Ellerslie students battled it out against a number of local schools in the Remuera cluster answering complex mathematical problems. It was impressive to see two of the teams get over 90 points. Well done to all students and staff who assisted with preparing the teams and during the evening of the competition

Professional Development - Staff Only Day Recap

The staff enjoyed a very successful staff only day on back at the end of week 4. The main focus was to look at the way the new Mathematics curriculum will be delivered from the beginning of 2025. The core theme for Mathematics next year is to ensure we deliver a "Balanced Maths Diet'. Some of these elements consist of:

Explicit teaching

- Rich, deep thinking tasks
- Students working collaboratively and individually
- Problem solving
- Building procedure fluency and visible thinking

The Science of Mathematics underpins much of the above and to ensure students achieve proficiency, teachers need to:

- Develop conceptual understanding and procedural fluency (concurrently)
- Develop problem solving skills
- Use multiple approaches (e.g. explicit for routine core instruction)
- Use formative assessment on an ongoing basis to monitor learning

Next year the Ministry of Education has set aside 2 professional learning days for staff to continue to upskill and unpack the new curriculum.

1. Keep it locked

Ask someone to help you set up a PIN or password to protect your phone, laptop and other devices, as well as all your accounts and the information contained in them.



2. Keep it private.

Don't share personal information like your address and phone number. Find out how to keep your profiles on social media private so only people you want to can see what you share.



3. Keep it to yourself

Everything you do online leaves what's known as a digital footprint — a record of what you do and say. Think very carefully before you say or post anything as you won't be able to stop other people sharing it — even those you don't know.



4. Keep it real.

Sometimes, people pretend to be someone else online. Check anyone who makes friends with you online is who they say they are. If you aren't sure, ask someone you know to help you find out



5. Keep it friendly

The internet is just like real life:

- be careful talking to, or sharing information with, people you don't know
- be kind
- · be respectful












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
